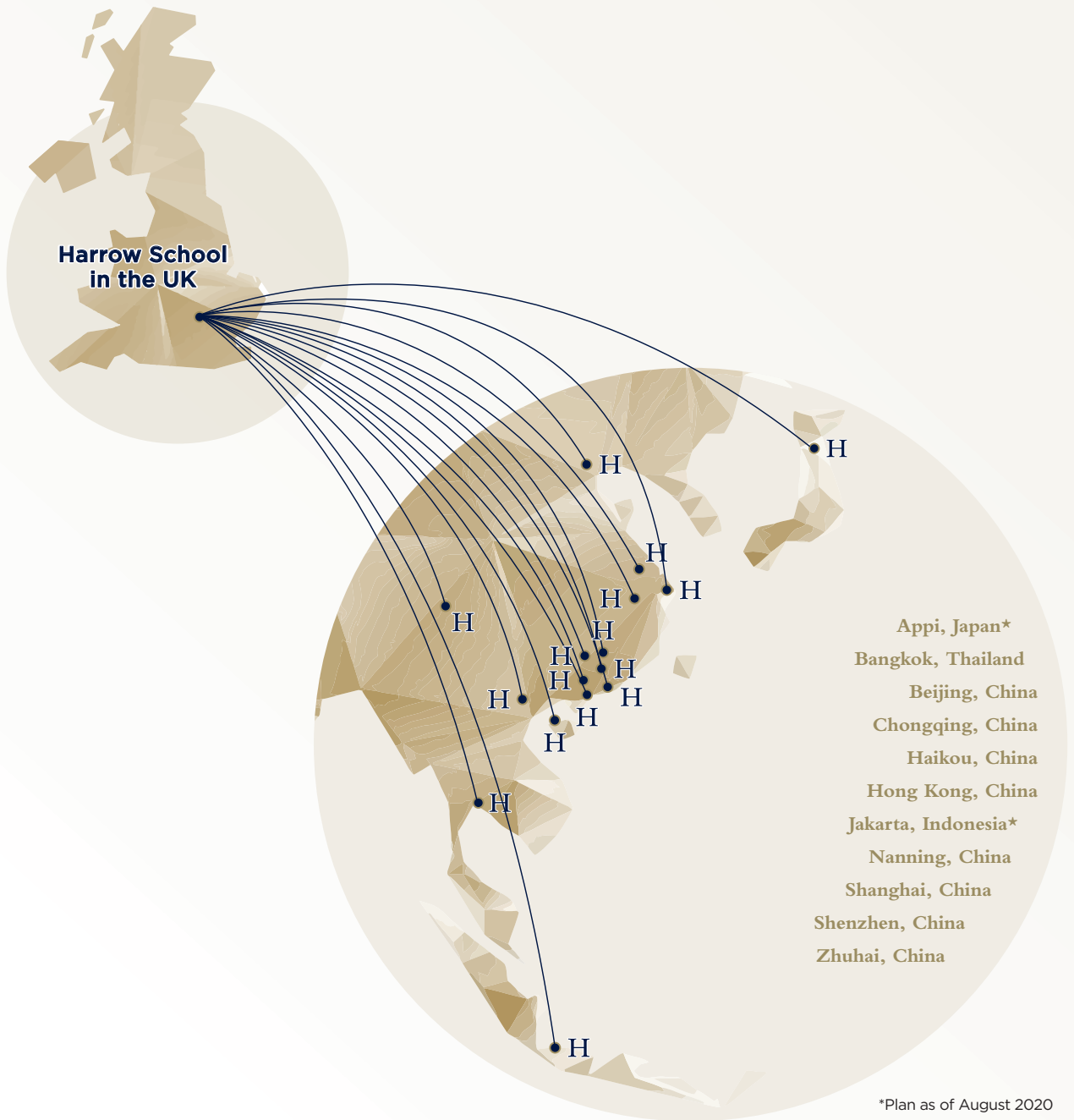

Harrow International Schools

The Harrow International Schools are independent day and boarding schools for students aged 18 months to 18 years. The age range is broad, as is the representation of nationalities. This international diversity creates a dynamic learning environment. Helping to shape the character of all students regardless of age and nationality are the Harrow School's Values that anchor the holistic educational approach focuses on individual care and support to develop the whole person.

Harrow International Schools are equally renowned for academic excellence, the House System, and enrichment and service activities that produce high-achievers with the leadership attributes and experiences that will serve them well throughout their lives and benefit the wider community tomorrow.



Our Curriculum

Early Years (to age five)

Our Harrow Little Lions Early Years Centre in each Harrow International School adopts the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) of the English National Curriculum encourages students to be curious, independent and happy. Children are able to develop creative thinking and essential life skills through an exciting, individualised curriculum that recognises that every child is unique. Children also benefit from lessons by specialists in Physical Education, Music, and Languages.

Pre-Prep Phase (age five to ten)

In Pre-Prep, children continue to develop essential literacy, numeracy and commuting skills. Emphasis is placed on the enjoyment of books and the teaching of reading and writing along with Mathematics and Coding. As they progress through Pre Prep, children are introduced to more specialist subjects in Languages, Music, Physical Education, Drama, Computing, Design Technology and Science.

Prep Phase (age ten to thirteen)

Modelled on the best practices of British Preparatory Schools and international Middle Schools, our Prep Phase is a blend of specialist-taught core subjects such as English, Mandarin, Mathematics, Science and Coding, with additional subjects taught including: Art, Coding, Drama, Design Technology, Geography, History, Music and Physical Education.

The Senior Phase (age thirteen to sixteen)

Designed to build on the knowledge and skills developed in the Prep Phase, our Senior School curriculum is increasingly academically demanding, focusing students on national and international public examinations. Building towards their IGCSE examinations (usually taken in Year 11), students are intellectually stretched. Subjects taught include: Art, Biology, Chemistry, Computing, Design Technology, Drama, English, Geography, History, Languages, Mathematics, Physics and Physical Education.

The Sixth Form (age sixteen to eighteen)

Following IGCSE examinations, students move into the 'Sixth Form' Phase of the School and prepare themselves for success at University. They complete a two-year suite of A-Level courses, that are regarded as the gold standard of the British education system and recognised worldwide for university entrance.

The Sixth Form years are both challenging and exciting. Students have the opportunity to specialise in subjects they particularly excel at and study these areas to an advanced academic level. Many students complete an 'Extended Project Qualification' (EPQ) which allows for the development of research skills and the exploration of a topic of special interest in even greater depth. Students also have an opportunity to contribute to the management and leadership of the school by taking on key student positions of responsibility such as Prefect, Senior Prefect, Head Girl, Head Boy, Student Academic Leadership Team and the Student Council.

Grade 1 to Grade 9 (age six to fourteen)

Chinese Curriculum - Western Pedagogy

Our curriculum is compliant with, and delivers, the Chinese National Curriculum through a genuine bilingual, bi-cultural programme. Students achieve academic excellence in both Chinese and English, at the same time developing leadership expertise.

Exclusively designed by senior education experts, our innovative approach blends the best of the Chinese National Curriculum (CNC) and the English National Curriculum (ENC). Utilising Harrow's world-renowned teaching methodologies and approaches, core elements of the CNC (Biology, Chemistry, English, ICT, Mathematics, and Physics) are delivered in English. The result is a powerful combination of East and West, leading to deep curriculum knowledge, international awareness and Chinese wisdom.

Alongside subjects taught in English, Language Studies, Moral Education, History, Geography and Chinese Cultural Studies are taught in Chinese using Chinese teaching methodologies. This approach, a first in China, ensures that HILA students benefit from both Western and Chinese approaches to learning, gaining enhanced knowledge and skills.

Senior Phase and Sixth Forms

After IGCSE, students move into the Sixth Form and prepare themselves for life at university. Taught in small classes, they complete a two-year A-Level programme regarded as the gold standard in the British education system and recognised worldwide.

The Sixth Form years are both challenging and exciting. Students have an opportunity to choose subjects they enjoy, studying these subjects to a depth which, in many cases, overlaps with university undergraduate content. Many students also complete an Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) which allows them to develop research skills and explore a topic of interest. Students also have an opportunity to contribute to the direction of the school by taking on key student leadership positions and enjoy growing independence.

Grade 10 (age fifteen)

Located in the Qianhai Co-operation Zone, Harrow International School (HIS) and Harrow Innovation Leadership Academy (HILA) Shenzhen Qianhai covers an area of 139,240 sqm with a total capacity to accommodate 2,100 students.

The campus connects Harrow School's Values with Qianhai's spirit. As an inner-city site, the school has a lawn area where the main sports grounds and outdoor activity spaces are located, ensuring the whole campus will have a vibrant atmosphere. The British garden landscaping is inspired by the setting of Harrow School in London.

The campus is designed to support a holistic approach to education, with sports and leisure areas, library and break out spaces, and canteens and lecture halls, allowing students to flow easily between the various teaching and activities areas, in order to learn, collaborate and socialise freely.

Shenzhen is the youngest first-tier city in China with the average age of the population under thirty. Rated as having the best air quality of all first-tier cities in China, Shenzhen is home to many tech companies like Tencent, DJI, Huawei and ZTE. As part of the larger Pearl River Delta, Shenzhen is within an hour of Hong Kong (45 minutes to our HIS), Dongguan, Foshan, Guangzhou, Zhuhai and Macao.

Bringing world-class bilingual education to Zhuhai, the opening of Harrow Innovation Leadership Academy Zhuhai (HILA Zhuhai) with full K-12 day schooling and boarding, represents a significant milestone for education in the Greater Bay Area.

HILA Zhuhai is situated in Hengqin, a prime location next to Novotown in the New District area while our Harrow Little Lions Early Years Centre catering kindergarten education is located in the popular residential area in Xiangzhou. 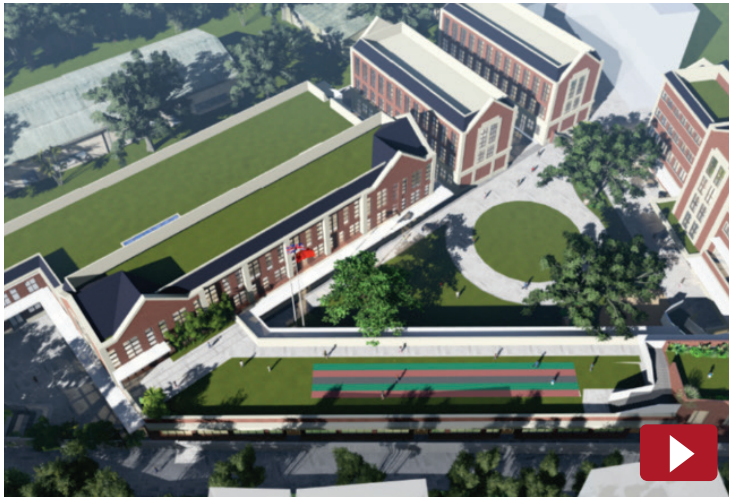

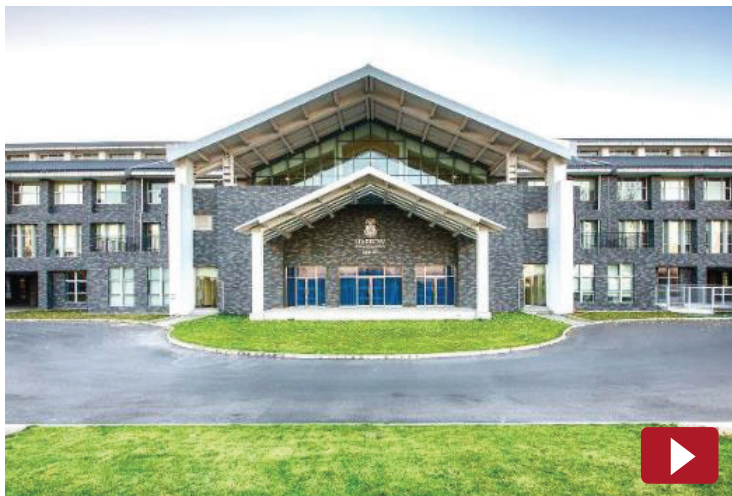

Developing a lifelong love of movement, students enjoy better physical, emotional and mental health.



The **Harrow Talent** programme challenges students to extend their comfort zones. Through the expressive arts, through debating, and through public speaking, students build self-confidence, creativity, courage and humility.

Our **Super Curriculum** provides students with a wide range of diverse outdoor education experiences, all in safe, if sometimes challenging, environments. From the first night away from home in Grade 1, to life-changing experiences skiing in Europe or exploring the history of Russia in Grade 12, expeditions allow students see the world, and themselves, in new lights.

The **Harrow Service** programme is a fundamental aspect of a Harrow education. In keeping with our mission, every student, even the very youngest, is provided with opportunities to make a positive contribution to the community. Our House System

Modelled on the best practices of Harrow School in the UK, from Pre Prep Phase (age 5), every student belongs to a House. Each House has its own distinctive name, a House colour, House flags and House Mistress or Master.

The House offers students a smaller, closer community within the school, broadening the range of activities and support available. House events include: Sports Days, Charity Events, Dance and Music Competitions and various Sports Competitions. In these numerous activities, community pride finds expression in a healthy competitive spirit.

A key strength of the House system is the vertical integration of different aged pupils. This creates a ‘family’ unit within which responsibilities are assigned to older students to care for and support their younger peers.

The House system is the most distinctive characteristic of a Harrow-branded education and is central to the school’s culture and success. The development of House communities is characterised by strong bonds and support networks within each House. The House Master or Mistress and Form Tutor knows each member of the House extremely well, allowing for close monitoring of academic performance as well as pastoral support. Therefore, if and when there is a problem the student will swiftly receive well judged, individualised and effective support to get back on track.



Our Boarding Community

Being a Boarder is the most authentic way to experience our holistic education; after all, Harrow School in the UK has been offering a boarding-only education for many decades.

Boarders benefit from being part of a community, from learning to live alongside others, and from having world-class facilities right on their doorstep.

All boarders can choose from a range of additional sporting, academic, creative and wellbeing activities. These sessions provide boarders with further opportunities to access the school's facilities, develop new and existing skills, support their mental health, and interact with peers from other Houses – all the while being continually supported by Harrow faculty members.

Uniquely for boarding students, we run additional supervised study sessions and provide focused academic support. Our younger students are offered language and Mathematics support, our older students can request tuition in any of their IGCSE or A Level subjects. In all cases, fully qualified Harrow teaching staff provide the additional lessons – all included within the Boarding fee.

As a teacher taking a role in the boarding house as a boarding parent, housemistress, housemaster or tutor is extremely rewarding, contributing to boarding house life and the boarding students experience brings a sense of community and belonging that will stay with you throughout your career.





Personalised Support, Pastoral Care

We recognise that every child is unique, with individual needs and requirements.

Through our pastoral systems, we offer each student personalised care, support and guidance. Small class sizes and the House system ensure that every student is known by name, and the teachers understand the students' strengths and areas for improvement.

This personalised pastoral support is centred on the 'home room' in the Lower School and the 'House' in The Upper School.

This personal attention ensures that we also know about the student's life outside of school: we celebrate their successes, we are supportive and effective when there are difficulties and we are expert and prepared for life's challenges. Creating strong bonds with students and being part of their journey through school life brings a real sense of making a difference to a student's life and achievement to teachers at Harrow schools.
